Thank you so much for your interest in the National Comedy Theatre Summer Comedy Camp. We are extremely excited to bring this program to New York and very much look forward to its success. In this packet, you will find applications and forms for you to review, sign and return to us to ensure the registration of your child. Class Sessions

- The NCT Summer Comedy Camp will be held over two weeks, Monday through Friday, August 9th - August 20th, 2010. Our schedule is as follows:

Improvisation: 10:00AM – 12:30PM

Sketch Comedy: 1:00PM – 3:30PM

Preparation for Class

- Students should wear comfortable clothing and be ready to move. Outfits should not be distracting to other students.
- Valuables should be left at home. Gaming devices, iPods and other electronic devices are not permitted to be used during class. The National Comedy Theatre is not responsible for lost or stolen items.
- Students who are staying all day will be required to provide their own packed lunch. They will not be permitted to leave the building to purchase any food. Please ensure that your child's lunch is clearly marked with his/her name. Also, please note, there are no drinking fountains on the premises, students are encouraged to bring bottled water. Beverages are available at the theater (\$2.00 for water/soft drinks). If your child is only enrolled in one of the courses, he/she may come early or stay late to visit with friends during lunch.

Pick Up/Drop Off

- All parents and guardians must complete the Transportation & Sign In/Sign Out Authorization form provided in this packet. This form is intended to provide NCT with the information on how your child will be getting to and from the theater each day, as well as individuals permitted to pick up your child at the end of each session.
- Morning Session Arrival Information: Students in the improvisation class should be dropped off/arrive between 9:45 and 10:00AM. Those students in the improv class who are not taking the sketch writing class must be picked up at 12:30PM
- Afternoon Session Arrival Information: Students who are only participating in the sketch writing class should be dropped off/arrive at the theater between 12:45 and 1:00PM. All students must be picked up between 3:30 and 3:45.
- Should your child need to leave early for any reason, parents are expected to write a note.

Public Transportation

- The National Comedy Theatre is located at 347 West 36th Street, very close to the 34th Street/Penn Station stop on the A/C/E or 1/2/3 lines.

Student Performance

- Our two week camp will culminate with a student performance at the National Comedy Theatre to showcase the work that we have done. Students will be provided with a limited number of tickets to the show. The showtime will be 1:00PM on Friday, August 20th. Students should plan to be in attendance the whole day.

Behavior Policy

- While we will certainly be working in a fun and relaxed environment, the National Comedy Theatre expects all students to be on their best behavior
- If, at any point during the class, the instructor feels that a student is being highly disruptive or, in any way, endangering the other students in the class, the instructor may require that the student leave the class for the remainder of the day. If such an event occurs, a parent or guardian will be contacted and the student may not return to the class until they have spoken with one of our NCT staff members.
- Students may not drink alcohol, smoke, or use any other controlled substances without a prescription while on the premises.
